Re: Notice of Data Security Incident

Dear Attorney General Labrador:

This notice is provided on behalf of my client, American Falls School District #381 ("AFSD"). On March 31, 2025, AFSD confirmed that a ransomware incident was impacting its computer network. AFSD immediately began working with legal counsel and a nationally recognized cyber security and digital forensics firm, to contain the incident, securely restore operations, investigate the scope of the incident, and mitigate any resulting harm. AFSD notified federal law enforcement regarding this incident and is cooperating with the investigation.

On April 28, 2025, as part of its ongoing investigation, AFSD determined that this incident involved unauthorized acquisition of personal information, as defined by Idaho law. AFSD is working with legal counsel and the digital forensics firm to identify and review the impacted data to determine what specific information may have been affected, and to whom that information relates, so that it can comply with any notification obligations. AFSD will be providing written notice to affected individuals, together with an offer of complimentary credit monitoring where appropriate.

AFSD also notified the ITS Chief Information Security Officer of this incident. Please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any questions or concerns.
